The Palace Pier isn't just for taking a stroll, it has popcorn stands, fish-and-chips stalls, fortune tellers and an excellent night club, amusement arcades and pubs. Brighton was originally a fishing village before it was colonised by the royals and the aristocracy. The fishermen lived in the winding lanes which are today's attractions and have become known as The Lanes. They offer cosy pubs, antique shops, book shops and cafés on every corner.
